High School Class Descriptions

Excellent Essays

"Excellent Essays" will teach your high schooler how to write an essay without the frustration and stress that often accompany high school essays. This **two week** class includes strategies for reading comprehension, critical thinking, brainstorming, structure, and editing.

Math Subjects

We offer "Get Ready" classes for Algebra, Geometry, Algebra 2, Alg. 2/Trig., and Pre-Calculus. Our classes are small and we ensure that the topics covered are relevant to each student. We fill important skill gaps from this year and preview next year's topics. Organizational Boot Camp a.k.a. Study Skills

Write Right (6th – 8th)
